IMPORTANT NOTICE COURSE INFORMATION UPDATES

NO PLAY ZONE on #10 is IN THE PENALTY AREA

At the right-hand bend on the riverbank side of #10 fairway, alongside the approach and walk down to the next level, is a roped NO ENTRY area which is, under our LOCAL RULES, currently designated as a "NO PLAY ZONE"

This NO ENTRY = NO PLAY ZONE is now deemed to be IN THE PENALTY AREA.

Consequently, the LOCAL RULE is further amended to state:

When a ball is at rest in this NO PLAY ZONE the player MUST take COMPULSORY

1-stroke penalty relief outside the penalty area
(2 club lengths lateral relief, stroke and distance, back-on-line).

The Rule 17.1e (2) option to take free relief by dropping a ball outside the NO PLAY ZONE but **IN the PENALTY AREA is NOT employable in this particular area of the course.**

NOTE: Playing the ball from the NO ENTRY = NO PLAY ZONE will incur the General Penalty (2 strokes)

WARNING: The NO ENTRY = NO PLAY ZONE area has been seriously undermined by the natural forces of the river below it

- Do NOT enter the NO ENTRY = NO PLAY ZONE area under any circumstances.
- Only retrieve golf balls from the NO ENTRY = NO PLAY ZONE if retrieval is possible without physically entering the zone
 - i.e. with the use of a golf club or ball retriever

IMPORTANT NOTICE COURSE INFORMATION UPDATES

TREES AND ROUGH on the LEFT SIDE of #11 (towards 17th & 12th fairways)

- This area is now a Penalty Area
- Standard Penalty Area relief options may be utilised

PENALTY AREA on the RIGHT of #13, short of the Green

- The rock/stone based excavated area **IS** Penalty Area Standard Penalty Area relief options may be utilised.
- The cut drain leading into the Penalty area is Abnormal Ground Condition from which FREE relief of 1-Club length may be taken.
- The mown area outside the Penalty area is "General Area" Standard Rules of Golf for a ball in the General Area apply.
- Any water overflowing from the Penalty Area into the General Area is TEMPORARY or, as it is also known, CASUAL WATER
